

Open Positions Specialist Dental Training Program Folktandvården Skåne (Public Dental Health Organization in Skåne, Sweden)

We invite outstanding applicants to the following open specialist training positions (start 2020/2021)

- **Periodontics** (2 positions)
- **Prosthodontics (prosthetic dentistry)** (2 positions)
- **Endodontics** (2 positions)
- **Orthodontics** (2 positions)
- **Pedodontics (pediatric dentistry)** (2 positions)

Skåne Care is the international gateway to the skills, services, and expertise offered by the public healthcare and dental care system in Skåne in Sweden's most southerly province. Together with Folktandvården Skåne, the regional public dental health organization, we welcome applications to our Specialist Dental Training Program.

Folktandvården Skåne is one of the largest public dental care providers in Sweden. It is fully owned by the regional council of Skåne and has over 1,400 employees in 67 clinics in 44 locations. It serves 490,000 customers with general and preventive care, specialist care, and dental care requiring hospital care.

Folktandvården is responsible for the specialist training of dentists in Sweden, by authority from and in accordance with the directives set by the National Board of Health and Welfare. The program offered to international dentists follows the guidelines for the equivalent training of Swedish dentists – a top quality educational program with high demands on the individual. Only excellent performance, achieved goals and completed studies grant a certification of specialization.

Non-European doctors with a governmental sponsorship can earn a specialist certificate from the public dental health organization within clinical training through Skåne Care. The Saudi Commission for Health Specialties classifies Swedish specialist dental training as a *Tier A* category training program. A framework agreement between Skåne Care and Saudi authorities governs the training program for candidates from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. A specialist medical training program is already ongoing with around 30 international doctors undergoing training within Region Skåne through Skåne Care.

Admissions are ongoing until the training positions are filled. Please make note of the below dates to participate in this application round.

1. We require your full application ([link to application form](#)) no later than **February 7th, 2019**. An initial screening will be performed after this date.
2. Selected candidates will be invited to a formal test and interview round that is expected to occur in Saudi Arabia following the initial screening. These tests are expected to occur during **March 2019** and will cover dentistry knowledge, linguistic ability, logical reasoning skills, interest and motivation.
3. References provided will be contacted. We will on the basis of the applications, test results and references short-list candidates for a final interview. Short-listed candidates will be invited to come to Sweden for a second round of meetings and interviews prior to potential admission to the training program.
