

Open Positions Specialist Medical Training Program Skåne University Hospital (Malmö and Lund, Sweden)

We invite outstanding applicants to the following open training positions

Rehabilitation Medicine (1 position)
Rheumatology (1 position)
Intensive- and Perioperative Care (2 positions)
Gastroenterology (2 positions)

Skåne Care is the international gateway to the skills, services, and expertise offered by the public healthcare system of Region Skåne in Sweden's southern province. World-renowned Skåne University Hospital in Lund and Malmö is the hub within our wide network of specialized hospitals in ten locations, with around 150 primary healthcare clinics managed or funded by Region Skåne. 30,000 healthcare professionals serve Skåne's 1.4 million residents as well as national and international referrals. Medical research, training and education is performed in close cooperation with Lund University and Malmö University.

Over 1,000 international and Swedish doctors are educated side-by-side with healthcare professionals and researchers in a highly structured program each year. The program is regulated by the Swedish National Board of Health and Welfare and follows the guidelines for the equivalent training of Swedish doctors.

Non-European doctors with a governmental sponsorship can earn a specialist certificate from public health authorities within clinical training through Skåne Care. The Saudi Commission for Health Specialties decided to classify Swedish specialist medical training as a *Tier A* category training program during 2018. A framework agreement between Skåne Care and Saudi authorities governs the training program for candidates from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Around 30 international doctors are currently undergoing training within Region Skåne through Skåne Care.

Admissions are ongoing until the training positions are filled. Please make note of the below dates to participate in this application round.

1. We require your full application ([link to application form](#)) no later than **February 7th, 2019**. An initial screening will be performed after this date.
2. Select candidates will be invited to a formal test- and interview round that is expected to occur in Saudi Arabia during **March 2019**. Tests will cover medical skills, linguistic ability, logical reasoning skills, interest and motivation.
3. References provided will be contacted. We will on the basis of the applications, test results and references short-list candidates for a final interview. Short-listed candidates will be invited to come to Sweden for a second round of meetings and interviews prior to potential admission to the training program.
