

Partial Objective c

A competent medical specialist must have

- knowledge of and proficiency in diagnosis and treatment of commonly-occurring diseases and serious diseases and disability from infancy to adulthood,
- knowledge of the normal growth, feeding, psychomotor and mental development of children and adolescents, and of diagnosis in order to be able to diagnose deviations in these respects at an early stage,
- a capacity to work preventively and in a family-oriented way with general health instruction, vaccinations and accident prevention,
- knowledge of the transfer process for chronically-ill adolescents from paediatric to adult care,
- a comprehensive view of the family, engaging with and respecting the needs and privacy of children and adolescents,
- an understanding of how illness affects children and adolescents and their families, and
- a capacity to accommodate the right of children and adolescents to participate in evaluation and treatment, based on their level of development.

In order to attain to this competency, the following are required:

- a capacity to work in a multidisciplinary team and to collaborate with other specialties within hospitals and outpatient care,
- a capacity to collaborate with social services, child care services, schools, nonprofits and social institutions,
- knowledge suitable to and a capacity to work for the rights of children and adolescents in society, both nationally and globally,
- an ethical and professional manner,
- good proficiency in clinical care centred on the needs of children, and
- a capacity to work for a healthy lifestyle for children and adolescents.
