

Partial Objective c

A competent medical specialist must, on the basis of knowledge of anatomy, neurobiology and physiology, have a command of

- rehabilitation of traumatic and vascular injuries and diseases,
- rehabilitation of other injuries and diseases of the central and peripheral nervous system that lead to comprehensive disability, and
- rehabilitation in cases of chronic pain.

Furthermore, a competent medical specialist

must

- have knowledge of rehabilitation in case of disability of locomotive organs or chronic neurological disease,
- have knowledge of the management of internal medical complications and conditions that can arise during rehabilitation,
- have knowledge of the management of adult rehabilitation,
- have a command of the psychological consequences of disease for patients and their family, and
- have a command of the effects of psychiatric disorders on rehabilitation.

Particular emphasis is to be placed on the interdisciplinary approach that characterizes rehabilitation medicine. It is therefore important to have knowledge of other professional groups and agents in the field and their methods.
